COVID-19 Safety Measures

Although things are better now than they were this time last year, COVID-19 has not yet gone away. In order to promote the health and safety of our school community, the following measures will be in effect until further notice.

- We will continue to use our upgraded air filtration throughout the building including the portable air filters in classrooms.
- Students, staff, and volunteers should continue to clean their hands throughout the day. Students will be reminded to use hand sanitizer as they enter the classroom.
- Students, staff, and volunteers will still be reminded to stay home when sick.
- Although no longer required, we will continue to use the daily Ruvna screenings at
 drop-off (and as students enter the school if arriving after drop-off time) for the time
 being. We found that these screenings were helpful in reminding us all to be aware of
 illnesses and to avoid the spread of viruses in the school. We will not be temperature
 screening at school unless there is reason to beleive that a student is sick.
- Masks will continue to be required indoors. Masks are not required to be worn outdoors by vaccinated or unvaccinated individuals. Anyone may continue to wear a mask outdoors.
- We will continue to follow the distancing rules. The state and county health
 departments have emphasized that we should try to maintain three feet of distancing
 whenever possible, but that this spacing rule should not prevent school from reopening
 in-person for all students.
- Until the spacing for lunch changes (currently it is at 6 feet), we will still need to have some classes eating in their classrooms on a rotating basis (or outdoors when possible).

Travel Quarantine

Another requirement of the health department that is intended to promote the health and safety of our community is the travel quarantine that is required of all unvaccinated individuals who travel out of the state of Washington. Please read the attached document for our plan to support students who are required to quarantine.

Pick-up and Drop-off Next Year

Please review the attached document for instructions about pick-up and drop off this coming school year. Afternoon pick-up will be changing back to our previous parking plan. Staff will be in the parking lot to help direct cars, answer questions, and keep everyone safe.

Thanks to your generosity last year, we were able to purchase Surface Go laptops so that, in addition to our 5th-8th grade BYOD program, our 1st-8th graders have authentic access to computers, both in and out of technology classes. We look forward to using these devices for meaningful and purposeful learning, support, creating, and sharing. To fully utilize powerful audio, video, and voice tools in the classroom, we are asking each 1st-8th grade student to bring a pair of headphones or earbuds to school along with his/her other school supplies.
