SLEs

Our **SLEs** embody the distinctive education that we provide at Sacred Heart School. We strive to offer all of our students a "complete education" in the sense that we are offer not only the core subjects of math, reading, writing, science, social studies and the like, but art, music, Spanish, drama, technology, library skills, and more which creates a balanced and wholistic education. In addition, we offer a "complete education" in the sense that we are not only teaching our students "subjects" but shaping their hearts and souls as well. The SLEs give expression to these moral and spiritual goals.

On the other hand, our SLEs demonstrate that we also provide an "incomplete education." This may sound like an odd thing for a principal to say. But what I mean is this: unlike teaching our students to read or do long division or balance a chemical equation, our SLEs represent a part of our students' education that will never be "finished" or "complete". Our sincere hope is that while they are here at SHS, our students learn to "work towards personal excellence" not just in 1st grade or 5th grade or 8th grade, but every day of their lives. We want our students to develop the habits necessary to "act with integrity, patience, and respect" at school, at home, on the playfield, in high school, in college, and in their workplace.

At Sacred Heart School we are educating the whole child. So, as we head to conferences next week, please keep in mind that your child's grades and MAPs scores are important. But equally important is the feedback you will receive about your child's development in terms of our SLEs. Taken together these things will provide you a more complete picture of how your child is learning and growing. - *Mr. Burroughs*
