

ESS applications for next school year are now available <u>online</u>. Please fill out the editable PDF, found at the bottom of that page, and email it to <u>Amy Davis</u> rather than submitting a hard copy. You will receive confirmation of enrollment (or notice of waitlist placement if necessary) **no later than the end of June**. I anticipate being able to approve all applications that are submitted prior to summer break. Next school year we will be introducing an afterschool ESS option for our Pre-K program. If the combination of ESS fees and tuition creates an unmanageable financial burden for your family, please contact <u>David Burroughs</u> to discuss tuition assistance. If the program does not fill to capacity, we will be able to offer a soccer season plan for those who only need ESS through the end of October. If this is possible, it will be communicated in August. I speak for the entire ESS team when I say we cannot wait to resume ESS and care for your kiddos in September!
