## **Important Reminders:**

In Social Studies, we will continue with our study of maps. We will map out a classroom and discuss how symbols are used on maps to give us information.


In Science, we will continue with our study of force. We will discuss how we create force by pushing and pulling and how changing the amount of force that is used on an object affects how it moves.




# Forces




